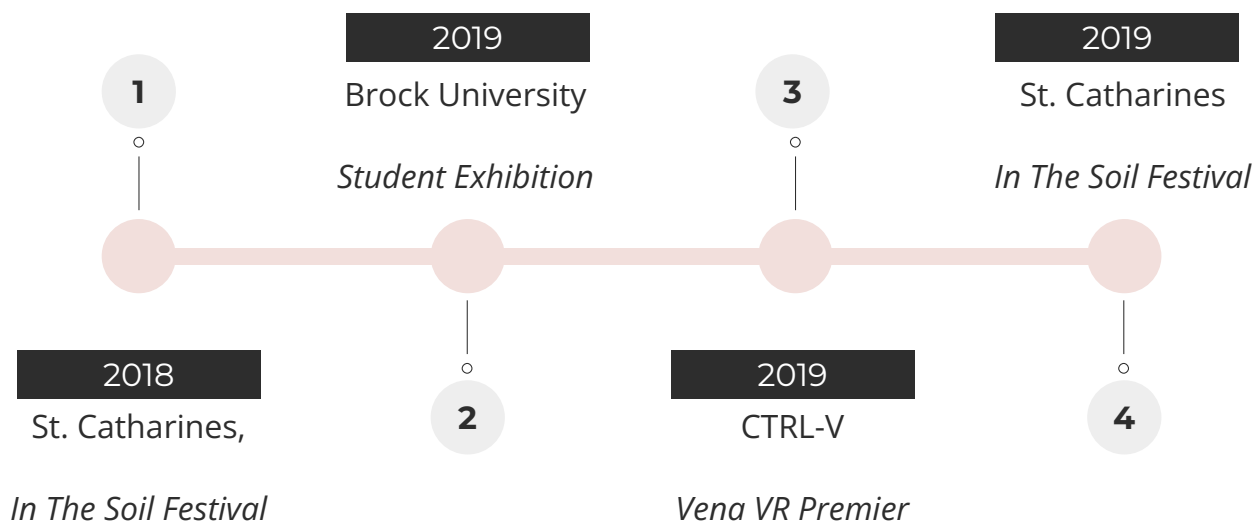
Creative Vision
